Footnotes

AS TOLD went up early to contest the pace outside of LA TORAH DE TARA, took over for good in the upper stretch, kicked clear, then was kept to her task. BOANA (GER) broke slowly, settled in behind horses, came out eight wide to advance into the stretch, edged in late and earned second. MALTESE INDY, outrun for six furlongs while in behind rivals, circled the field 10 wide into the upper stretch, then was slowly gaining while angling in late. BRAVINGTHETHUNDER, checked approaching the first turn, raced near the inside, moved three or four wide between foes into the final furlong but lacked a late account. INSIDE RUN drifted in at the start, raced within easy striking distance near the inside, eased out three or four wide for the drive but was empty late. LA TORAH DE TARA contested the pace inside the winner until the stretch and faltered. DROMARA, between horses three or four wide, came out for the drive but failed to rally. FAMILIAR STORY, well placed four or five wide to the stretch, flattened out. RENAISSANCE FAIR, unhurried six wide, moved nine wide into the upper stretch and never menaced. BIBI KARAM (IRE) tracked the pace four wide until the stretch and faded.
