Footnotes

LANTANA MOB, three or four wide early while tracking the pace, was asked nearing the final quarter, crept after front-running READY IN THE MORN, took over from that one leaving the furlong grounds and was under intermittent urging to draw well clear. READY IN THE MORN gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with HOWBOUTTHISDANCE, shook off that one, was engaged by the winner at the eighth pole and wasn't a match while saving the place. HOWBOUTTHISDANCE vied for the lead outside of READY IN THE MORN, was four wide in the late going and held his position while not a threat. MATTY'S TRAIL, outrun for three furlongs, came out seven wide into the lane and managed a mild gain. HALTOM hopped while breaking slowly, moved to the rail, worked his way out five wide for the drive but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SLEUSE, bumped at the start by DOUBLE OR NOTHING and steadied when forced in, was outrun to the stretch, made a six wide bid into the final furlong but failed to continue. SMIRK was outrun to the stretch and passed tired foes. DOUBLE OR NOTHING bore in on SLEUSE at the break, raced in contention five wide into the upper stretch and flattened out in the late going. PULASKI RUNNER weakened leaving the turn. TIZTHEMANINTHEMOON never was prominent. THE WRECKER faded approaching the stretch.
