JULIA'S STAR within striking distance near the hedge, angled out four wide leaving the second turn and closed well to be up in time. LOOK WHO'S RITZY forwardly placed three wide, challenged from that path on the second turn and held on gamely. PERFECT FOREVER in hand for a half, raced three wide past the three furlong marker and made a good late gain. RARE EVENT outrun along the inside, steadied in upper stretch behind KICKER, worked her way out through midstretch and closed well late. COLONIAL EMPRESS set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. GOTTAHAVEADREAM prompted the pace off the inside, stayed on well to the final furlong and also weakened late. KISS within striking distance, raced four wide on the second turn and lacked the needed closing bid. KICKER reserved off the inside, brushed the hedge in upper stretch, steadied then tired.. GETAWAY SPOT four wide on the second turn, was no threat.
