Older, 125 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes on the turf in 2012, allowed 2 lbs. The field will be limited to 12. If more than 12 entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest 2011-2012 earnings. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turfcourse, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.)

Footnotes

GUYS REWARD was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, circled five wide to make a bold bid, was floated out further through the drive but wore down SERUNI in the final strides. SERUNI stalked the pace four wide, drew even leaving the second turn, shook clear with a furlong to run, drifted out to meet the bid of GUYS REWARD but was unable to resist that one late. SCOTUS settled saving ground, shifted out after six furlongs, advanced between horses through the stretch and was along in time to earn the show. SAL THE BARBER bobbled at the start, settled in hand three deep, ranged up four wide through the second turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. STEVE'S DOUBLE disputed the pace two wide, weakened entering the stretch and faded. ZIMMER contested the pace along the hedge for six furlongs and retreated.
