MOE MAN within striking distance, made a bold four wide move on the turn to challenge, drifted out just a bit and bumped FIRE ALARM inside the final furlong then edged clear late. FIRE ALARM reserved early, made a quick six wide move on the turn, battled the winner to midstretch, was bumped by that one inside the final furlong and held on to be second best. ADULARE behind the leaders, challenged three wide on the turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. CHANNELING within striking distance, made a five wide move on the turn to challenge approaching the stretch but tired in the drive. QUIET MAN outrun early, raced off the inside on the turn and lacked a late bid. HE'S SO PROUD forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and faded. FAIR DINKUM set the pace along the inside, stayed to the stretch and faded.
