NATIVE RULER close up while off the inside, maintained good position around the turn, split rivals once in the stretch, gained a short lead in deep stretch and was narrowly best. GENERAL QUARTERS close up from the start while unhurried, drifted in a bit and steadied off the heels of POINTING NORTH (SAF) once in the turn, angled out a bit to be five wide, moved up in that path approaching the stretch and finished willingly late while not able to get to the winner. AGASTACHE pressed the pace three wide and under a rating hold, challenged in earnest approaching the stretch and held on gamely to the finish. WISE DAN bumped with HOMERUN BERTY at the start, moved up inside to vie for the early lead dropped back a bit after a half, came again to gain a short lead in midstretch but weakened. HOMERUN BERTI bumped at the start, alternated for the lead while in hand, battled to the final furlong and tired late. POINTING NORTH (SAF) forwardly placed four wide, held on well to the final furlong and tired.
