FINNEGANS WAKE unhurried three wide, angled out for the drive and closed fast to be clear. ANIMAL SPIRITS forwardly placed from the start, moved closer in the three path on the second turn, challenged with a furlong to go and held on gamely. AT THE PULPIT within reach from the start, moved up four wide on the second turn, challenged in midstretch but weakened. EXPLAIN closest to the pace off the inside, reeled in the leader after six furlongs, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but tired. IN THE MIDNIGHT set the pace along the inside, stayed on well to the final furlong and weakened. GODARD outrun early, saved ground on the second turn, drifted out in midstretch and made a late gain. CLASS PRESIDENT within reach early, failed to respond in the stretch. KEY TO FAME outrun for a half, raced three wide on the second turn, was carried out in midstretch and lacked a late bid.
