Footnotes

SINGIT broke awkwardly and was steadied, trailed on the backstretch four wide, moved out farther on the course around the turn, was seven wide for the drive and closed determinedly to be along in time. NICOLE'S DREAM gained the lead early, edged in three wide while drawing clear, shook off ANGEL TRUMPET entering the stretch, then failed to contain the winner's surge. MOCHA QUEEN, outrun to the stretch and near the inside, eased out around SARASOTA (ARG) when advancing nearing the final furlong, moved back inside and was going well at the end. HORTENSE (CHI), outsprinted early and five wide most of the way, lacked a final response. ANNA EM, up close early, was steadied behind SPEEDY SONATA leaving the backstretch, eased out between foes on the turn, remained a threat into the final furlong five wide but failed to fire. ANGEL TRUMPET maneuvered in early to track the pace four or five wide, raced close up into the stretch and weakened. SHE'S A REBEL TOO, outrun early and four wide, angled out seven wide for the drive and failed to rally. SPEEDY SONATA, up close early, moved in behind front-running NICOLE'S DREAM, moved off the inside for the drive but flattened out. SHAUNAVON, five wide, weakened nearing the stretch. SARASOTA (ARG) hopped at the start, was steadied, raced between foes near the inside and weakened in the stretch run. GOLDFLEAFED MIRROR tired after three furlongs. REVOLUTIONARY ACT was outrun and 10 wide in the stretch run.
