FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each on or before May 28, 2005 or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start with \$100,000 added and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup Nominees only. The host association's monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Closed Saturday, May 28, 2005 with 16 nominations.

Footnotes

MISS MATCHED gained the lead at the start, moved in to show the way in hand two wide, repelled a mild challenge from CAROLINE'S GOLD upon going six furlongs, kicked clear again into the upper stretch and was going under energetic handling the remainder. CULINARY, never far back, eased out between foes on the backstretch to race three or four wide, continued between rivals on the far turn, had aim at the winner five wide through the drive but wasn't good enough. CAROLINE'S GOLD, up close inside early, moved out three or four wide on the backstretch to press the winner, was asked for her best at the five-sixteenth pole and gradually weakened in the drive. ATLAS VALLEY, reserved early and five or six wide on the backstretch, raced in contention into the lane but lacked a closing account. SHE'S THAT CAT, in hand early while following the leaders the three or four wide, moved between rivals nearing the final quarter, remained four wide for the drive and lacked a response while angling closer to the inside late. GALLANT SECRET, a bit awkward to start and steadied lightly, settled three wide, moved inside on the far turn, remained near the rail for the drive but had no rally. RUNWAY MODEL tracked the pace early while four or five wide, raced within easy striking distance, bore out steadily approaching the stretch, continued 10 wide and was finished.
