**Footnotes**

CANELA, slow to begin and forced out when bumped by GET IN GEAR, settled five wide, raced well off the inside throughout, leaned in about the sixteenth pole brushing DEPUTY ON CALL and edged clear late under strong handling. RAYWICK went up between foes to contest the pace early, poked a head in front entering the stretch, then couldn't handle the winner late while fully extended to dead heat with DEPUTY ON CALL for second. DEPUTY ON CALL tracked the pace four wide, inched to a slight lead in the upper stretch, was brushed by the winner at the sixteenth pole and couldn't match strides with CANELA thereafter while finishing on even terms with RAYWICK for second. CRITICAL ACCLAIM, never far back and four wide, angled to the rail for the drive but failed to offer the needed response. RAVENCLIFF battled for the lead inside to the stretch and tired. RACEHORSE DAVIS, angled to the rail early, saved ground but was empty in the drive. GET IN GEAR swerved out at the start bumping the winner, raced four wide within striking distance to the stretch, angled seven wide and tired.
