Footnotes

PERSIMMON RIDGE, rated near the inside from early on, awaited room at the quarter-mile ground while edging closer, split horses four wide in the upper stretch and drove clear late. WILLOW WIND, lightly rated early while tracking the leaders five wide, made a solid run into the lane, stuck a head in front at the furlong grounds but couldn't sustain the needed momentum as second best. GILDED NIP moved up four wide early to vie for the lead outside of KYLERS MIDGE, battled close up into the stretch and weakened. PERKY PEAKS, unhurried early, moved in three wide, came out six wide for the drive and offered a minor gain while unable to menace. KYLERS MIDGE was sent to a narrow lead inside early, moved clear before going a half, made the pace to the stretch while dueling and weakened. PATTI PEACH, well placed early, raced in behind the leaders and weakened approaching the stretch. DEBORAH (CHI), outrun from the start, never menaced and was eight or nine wide in the stretch run.
