Footnotes

ADORATION eased off the inside on the first turn, tracked front-running ROAR EMOTION three wide under light rating, inched to challenge midway on the far turn, reached the front entering the upper stretch, took over, opened a clear lead, then was under stout right-handed encouragement the remainder to hold sway. BARE NECESSITIES, unhurried early, raced three or four wide, briefly awaited room leaving the three-sixteenths pole, angled outside the winner to made a bid between foes five wide and was second best. LA REASON, reserved early and angled inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out four wide, angled inside the winner in the late going and offered a minor gain. ANGELA'S LOVE stalked the pace within easy striking distance four or five wide into the stretch and came up empty. YELL, close up at once, was eased back from between foes approaching the first turn, raced in behind front-running ROAR EMOTION, raced in a challenging position to the stretch, eased out three wide but was empty. ROAR EMOTION bobbed lightly at the start, moved to the fore soon after, raced near the inside, managed a narrow advantage to the stretch and faded.
