TIZZY within striking distance three wide, angled out a bit for the drive and proved narrowly best. CARNIVAL RIDE outrun early, advanced three wide after five furlongs, angled to the outside for the drive and closed fast but missed. BYRNWYCK WEST set the pace along the inside and held on gamely. MATCHING WHITES forwardly placed three wide, challenged on the second turn but tired in the final furlong. LITTLE LIZARD close up while off the inside, faded. SOUPERMAN HIMSELF within striking distance to the stretch, gave way. SIX TOKENS was outrun. JAM TODAY trailed.
