DOUBLE ESPRESSO reserved for a half, advanced inside into the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed well to be up in time. SUSIES GAL close up four wide, challenged late on the second turn, gained a short lead in midstretch and held on gamely. STONE LEGACY outrun for a half, made a mild middle move, angled out for the drive but lacked a late bid. SYRIANA'S SONG set the early pace off the inside, dropped back a bit before a half, came again on the second turn to challenge, battled into the final furlong and weakened. ELIZABETH PARK broke in the air, steadied on the first turn inside the leader, took over before a half, responded when headed in upper stretch, took over again with a furlong to go but tired late. ON A ROLL close up three wide, tired.
