SPOOKY'S READY quickly sprinted clear and angled to the inside, set the pace along the inside, repulsed a bid by DANCING ROMAN on the turn and drew clear under steady urging. GOOD LORD forced out at the start, was forwardly placed three wide and lodged a mild bid for the place. ASPIRE drifted out at the start and bumped MY ENTICEMENT, raced forwardly near the rail and lacked a late bid. RICKY TICK within striking distance off the inside, improved his position while no real threat. SPICER drifted out at the start, was straightened to race within striking distance while off the inside, steadied on the turn then lacked a late bid. DANCING ROMAN pressed the pace off the inside, challenged the winner on the turn but tired in the drive. MY ENTICEMENT bumped out at the start, was no threat. MAX THE KNIFE was outrun while four wide.
