BLUE ORLEANS stumbled at the start, recovered quickly, set the pace along the inside and held sway late. SOUNDWAVE forced the pace outside the winner and held on gamely to be gaining late. SONG OF A SIREN lost her footing at the start, recovered to be close up inside, steadied early on the turn, was reserved to the stretch and lacked the needed rally along the inside. WILD TIZZY bumped with TIME COUNTS entering the turn when four wide and within reach of the leaders then was no late threat. MOVE ME UP outsprinted early, raced four wide on the turn and improved her position while no threat. DANCING COMPASS forwardly placed early, was bumped when six wide into the turn then tired in the drive. TIME COUNTS bumped when five wide entering the turn then was no menace. KATHMANBLU was outrun. PLAYING PIRATES reared at the start and was no factor while five wide. MENWOLF close up early, faded.
