STAKES Jefferson Cup S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a graded sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the turf other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, May 29, 2010 with 33 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Sixteenth mile.). GLEAM OF HOPE drifted out at the start tightening up outer rivals, angled out three wide on the first turn when outrun, commenced his rally in the four path late on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and closed well to be up in time. PSYCHIC INCOME within striking distance three wide, moved closer four wide on the second turn then rallied willingly late. ASPHALT bumped at the start, was a bit keen entering the first turn when racing in hand along the inside, angled out three wide on the second turn, took over in that path entering the stretch but was outfinished. OUR DOUGLAS reserved off the rail, moved between rivals on the second turn, angled out for the drive but went evenly in the final furlong. LOST APTITUDE set the pace near the rail, responded when challenged before a half, held on well to the stretch and weakened. GUYS REWARD bumped at the start, was reserved along the inside, maintained good position along the inside to the stretch and lacked a rally. DONT TELL KITTEN forwardly placed three wide, moved out a path entering the stretch and tired. FORMULAFORSUCCESS closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged before a half, battled for the lead to the stretch and tired. SCOTTKEITH'SKITTEN drifted in at the start, raced within striking distance off the rail and tired.
