**Footnotes**

TIDAL VOLUME sprinted clear, set the pace near the rail, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. DANCING ROMAN within striking distance off the inside, angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild late bid. GOLD FOR CASH outstripped early, raced in the four path around the turn and made a late gain outside. TORO GRANDE outrun early, raced off the inside on the turn, angled out for the drive but could not threaten. HENRY'S TIME stumbled at the start, raced closest to the winner off the inside and tired in the drive. STAKE OUT failed to menace while off the inside. CARSON'S DASH three wide on the turn, had nothing left late. E KNOWS WHY was outrun. MEDIA CONTACT forwardly placed off the rail, faded.
