ONE BY THE KNOWS, well placed inside early, eased out four wide on the turn to go after front-running DANCING MISSILE, reached the front a furlong out and was kept to his task. PROVEN CURE settled three wide, rallied inside entering the stretch, loomed a solid threat but wasn't good enough. DANCING MISSILE lunged at the start, sprinted clear, made the pace into the stretch and weakened late. GALLANT FROLIC, inside early, swung out five wide for the drive but was empty. LIBITO POINT, in contention four wide early, faded approaching the stretch. This race originally was carded at five furlongs on the turf. It was switched to the main track. Trifecta wagering was canceled.
