Footnotes

SEMIFINAL went up early from between foes to force the pace, moved to the fore just before going a half, drew clear into the upper stretch and was kept to her task. SLEWGIANA, within striking distance and saving ground into the lane, came out and split foes four wide at the furlong grounds and was second best. SINFULINDULGENCE, outsprinted early and three or four wide to the stretch, angled five or six wide for the drive and improved position while unable to seriously menace. JIMANI, outrun four wide for a half, continued five wide into the final furlong to make a run but failed to sustain the needed momentum. MINEY'S AWESOME forced the pace three abreast into the stretch and faltered. INDIAN FIGHT gained the lead inside early, showed the way for almost a half and weakened. JOYOUS APPEAL, well placed four wide for a half, weakened soon after and was seven wide through the stretch. COLEE BEAR, near the inside and outrun to the lane, swung out eight wide for the drive but never fired.
