STAKES Regret S. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$7,500 at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 twice over a mile on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a graded sweepstakes over a mile on the turf, 4 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the turf other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, May 30, 2009 with 19 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.)

Footnotes

KEERTANA attended the pace three deep, bid between horses entering the stretch, forged a narrowly lead with a furlong to run and held stubbornly to the wire. THE BEST DAY EVER settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance through the second turn, swung to the outside entering the stretch, finished well and was getting to the winner late. HOT CHA CHA settled in hand off of the inside while well placed, launched her bid leaving the second turn, was blocked and altered course to the outside, shifted back to the inside, found room late and finished well once clear. BANKER'S CHOICE fought restraint early, drifted out five wide to be clear, drew even entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SUPER PONI disputed the pace two wide, contested the issue to the final furlong and weakened. OCULUNA set the pace along the hedge, was headed entering the stretch and faltered during the drive. PRYTANIA settled near the back of the pack four wide and lacked a response. RENA settled between horses near the tail of the field, showed little in a dull effort, was eased to the wire but walked off.
