FREE BRAVE made a steady advance circling four wide, and was all out to wear down HANDS ON in the final strides. HANDS ON sped clear to dictate terms, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. PARIOLI'S TRICK was hustled along between horses, steadied in traffic with three furlongs to run, angled out and finished willingly once clear. EBBTIDE chased the pace three wide to the final furlong and weakened. POWER SURGE was hustled along between horses, took an awkward step near the three-eighths pole and went evenly thereafter. PRICELESS BULL checked a bit before going a quarter, recovered quickly and contended along the inside, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. IN CLASSIC FASHION was unhurried into stride, made a belated gain five wide but was never a factor. ILIKEWHATIAMDOING pressed the pace from between horses but was through early and dropped out.
