**Footnotes**

RIGBY stalked the pace three deep, forged command entering the stretch, opened clear then was all out to just last. SUN BEAR pitched his head and was caught unprepared at the start and was away behind his field, made a long drive circling the pack, finished well and was gaining with every stride. SERUNI was allowed to settle, advanced four wide through the second turn, kept on well between horses but wasn't quite good enough. JOSHUA REYNOLDS settled saving ground, was caught in tight and clipped heels near the three-eighths pole, angled out and came again and was making up ground. PEDROLINO contended between horses, came three wide to make his bid, but lacked the needed late response. DAPPER ZAPPER was allowed to settle, advanced between rivals through the second turn, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. PLEASANT AIR opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the second turn and gave way once headed. TWILIGHT BAY failed to respond. HARRODS CREEK showed little. JUSTICE HARLAN was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and dropped out. CHAIRMAN was outrun.
