Footnotes

TAP THE ANSWER, never far back, moved up three wide to force the pace on the backstretch, reached the front midway of the second turn, turned back a challenge from ALLIE NORTH nearing the final furlong, edged clear soon after, then was hard ridden to last over SHES LIKE RIO. The latter, well placed early, fell back approaching the stretch while saving ground, angled six wide about the three-sixteenths pole, then was slowly getting to the winner. ALLIE NORTH, steadied in behind rivals nearing the first turn, saved ground, came four wide into the stretch, gained about even terms with TAP THE ANSWER at the furlong grounds but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SEA SIDE QUEEN went up early to stalk the pace three or four wide, continued prominently into the final furlong and weakened. STARK PASSAGE, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild bid in the upper stretch but failed to continue. LOOKAWAY DIXIELAND failed to reach contention. IT'S A DANCE failed to rally in an even effort. WORLD STORM gained the lead soon after the start, worked her way inside, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and tired. OLDIE was outrun and wide much of the way. VILLAGE GREEN faded leaving the second turn.
