Footnotes

KISS THE DEVIL tracked the leaders from early on while four wide, moved to the fore in the upper stretch, edged clear, drifted in for a stride at the eighth pole putting MOSTBEAUTIFULSOUND in a bit tight, then maintained her advantage under urging. MALTESE INDY, never far back while racing in behind the leaders, moved between foes approaching the stretch, angled four or five wide for the drive and was fully extended for her position. WELL CONSIDERED, hung six wide into the first turn, maneuvered in soon after, raced between rivals, came out six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. SUN AT MIDSUMMER, unhurried early and five wide much of the way, reached contention a furlong out but gained only slightly in the late stages. ROSE TROIENNE, outrun from the outset and saving ground for six furlongs, came out eight wide for the drive and improved position. MOSTBEAUTIFULSOUND gained the lead inside early, made the pace into the stretch and, while weakening, was checked at the furlong grounds when the winner drifted in. CIRQUE VIEW saved ground early, angled six or seven wide into the upper stretch and failed to menace. CHEROKEE IN SOLANO saved ground, was checked at the five-sixteenths pole behind JOANIE'S JETT and faded. EASABEAU FILLE raced near the inside between foes and tired. JOANIE'S JETT pressed the pace for nearly a half and gave way soon after.
