Footnotes

CHICKASAW went up early to press pacesetting ASHER under light rating, took over just before going a half, made the balance of the pace and was under intermittent urging to increase her lead. ENQUIRY WOMAN, within striking distance while four or five wide, was put to a drive at the five-sixteenths, followed the winner into the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. DANZIG MATILDA, angled inside soon after the start, saved ground while in hand, came out six wide to rally, loomed prominently the last eighth but failed to respond. ASHLEY ANNE'S WISH, within striking distance and saving ground into the stretch, came out to make a run from between foes when straightened for the drive but came up empty. ASHER gained the lead inside early, made the pace for nearly a half, surrendered it to CHICKASAW, continued forwardly until nearing the stretch and faded. MS. CLOTHES HOSS forced the pace three abreast to the far turn and weakened gradually.
