Footnotes

SOMETHING RUSHING, within easy striking distance, was inside while edging closer on the final turn, came out four or five wide when straightened for the drive and was ridden hard to prevail. CYANE'S THUNDER, always well placed, made a bold run four wide into the final furlong, battled on even terms for the lead but wasn't quite good enough. DYNAREIGN stalked the pace most of the way while four or five wide, gained a slim lead approaching the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. BIM'S BABY BUN settled four wide early, was unhurried for a mile, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE gained the lead early, made the pace three wide, was headed before going six furlongs by MORE RIBBONS, regained the advantage but weakened entering the stretch. AVENTURA PLACE, slammed from both sides at the start, was unhurried early, raced three or four wide, reached contention a quarter-mile out but was empty in the drive. CONTESTED broke out at the start into AVENTURA PLACE, raced within easy striking distance early while saving ground, moved out five wide after six furlongs, made a mild bid around the final turn but flattened out in the drive. FEELING SO PRETTY never was prominent. PRINCE MARTIN was used up the opening half forcing the pace. REGAL REPROACH never reached contention. WINGS OF OISIN, well placed for a mile while four or five wide, faded soon after. MORE RIBBONS moved in early to press front-running MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE four wide, gained a slight, brief lead just before going six furlongs, lost the advantage back to MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE and weakened after a mile.
