Footnotes

MORGHYN outrun near the rail, angled out on the turn, came wider for the drive, drifted in a bit once in the stretch, challenged inside the final furlong and edged off late. EVEN TEMPO within striking distance, advanced four wide on the turn, took over with a furlong to go and held on gamely. NONESUCH KISS within striking distance, lost position on the turn, moved to the inside for the drive and improved her position while no real threat. CAT HOP hopped in the air at the start, angled to the outside soon after, made a good five wide middle move but tired in the final furlong. HOUR QUEEN reserved three wide, moved closer on the turn, waited in upper stretch when lacking a clear path, angled out when the winner rallied past then lacked a late bid. MENIFEECENT vied for the lead along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. GENIVER forwardly placed along the inside, gave way in the final furlong. PECA JONES pressed the pace between rivals, battled to the stretch and faded. FIRST INSTALLMENT forced the pace three wide and gave way.
