Footnotes

SLANDER was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, navigated the trouble on the second turn, swung six wide entering the stretch and was up in the final strides. NEWSTOUSE attended the pace along the inside, checked sharply to avoid her stricken rival near the three furlong marker, shifted out and came again between horses but was unable to resist the winner. WINTER'S CHILD tracked the pace three wide, inherited a clear lead on the second turn, continued on well but grudgingly gave way between rivals. JONES ZING settled in hand, ranged into striking distance four wide, was carried out further as NEWSTOUSE maneuvered around GOT IT TOGETHER on the second turn, came to level terms entering the stretch, forged a narrow lead but weakened during the drive. WITH EXCELLENCE settled saving ground, swerved out to avoid trouble with three furlongs to run, got through and came again and was making up ground. OCEAN ROAD was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, loomed a danger entering the stretch but flattened in the final furlong. SAUCY SARAH failed to respond and was distanced through the stretch. OAKUM broke slow, was unhurried into stride, was taken up on the second turn, pulled up nearing midstretch but walked off. GOT IT TOGETHER sped clear to set the pace, went wrong near the three-eighths pole, was pulled up sharply and vanned off.
