Footnotes

TIM'S TALENT worked his way nicely to the inside while gaining the lead, made the balance of the pace and was kept to his task in the drive. AMERICA'S STORM, nine wide early, edged in around the turn to track the winner, loomed a solid threat in the drive but wasn't good enough. UNBRIDLED AFFAIR, outsprinted early, reached contention near the inside between foes in the upper stretch but could gain only slightly at the end. POLITICAL TRIUMPH maneuvered inside early, raced in behind the leaders, came out five or six wide for the drive, then flattened out in the final furlong. ROCKET EXPRESS, bumped at the start and forced in, was outrun early, reached contention between rivals when straightened for the drive but lacked a further account. LAST INTENTION followed the leaders within striking distance five or six wide throughout and was empty the last eighth. PEEKSKILL was outrun into the stretch and improved position while unable to menace. NOTABLE EDITOR saved ground but faded. WEEKEND MIRACLE, used early to gain a position near the inside, faded leaving the turn. INCA HALO, close up between foes early, tired after three-eighths. O SEQUOYAH drifted in at the start bumping ROCKET EPXRESS, then was outrun. LOTSA BULL was never close .
