Footnotes

BRIGHT LINE, in hand while tracking the pace four wide from early on, commenced a sweeping run nearing the stretch, took over a quarter-mile out, drew clear and continued under strong hand encouragement in the late going. PRETTY SIMPLE was sent to the front two wide,made the pace until the quarter-mile ground and was no match for the winner thereafter. ARTISTIC ESCAPE, sluggish to start, briefly trailed, raced near the inside, maneuvered four wide into the lane and was unable to gain in the final furlong. FAST INCLUDED, within striking distance and four or five wide, failed to rally in an even effort. YELLOW FLAG settled near the inside early, fanned five wide into the lane and had no serious response. TACHYON raced near the inside and weakened approaching the stretch. BEPPIN, fractious in the gate prior to the start, pressed front-running PRETTY SIMPLE three wide and tired nearing the stretch. GLORY NOW settled near the inside early and was always outrun.
