FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each on or before June 2, 2007 or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 each by 12:00 noon, Friday, June 8, 2007. \$1,500 to pass the entry box; \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, June 9, 2007. The maximum number of starters for the Fleur De Lis will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights with consideration to age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay the entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 2, 2007 with 17 nominations.

INDIAN VALE went up early to press front-running FIERY PURSUIT, inched to the front just before going six furlongs, then held sway under solid left-handed encouragement. ASI SIEMPRE, reserved early two or three wide, advanced near the inside around the far turn, came out between horses four or five wide entering the upper stretch, had aim at the winner through the final furlong but wasn't good enough. KETTLEONEUP, taken in hand early and angled near the rail, eased out three wide on the backstretch, was outrun for six furlongs, circled rivals six or seven wide into the lane and was going well at the end. ERMINE tracked the pace three or four wide from the outset, raced in closest attendance to INDIAN VALE into the final furlong and came up empty. ROLLING SEA raced in a striking position two or three wide into the upper stretch and flattened out. FIERY PURSUIT moved to the front two wide early, lost the advantage to the winner just before going three-quarters and tired. BAGHDARIA, unprepared while breaking slowly, raced four wide, gave way on the far turn, was pulled up in the upper stretch and vanned off.
