Footnotes

PICKAPOCKET reserved off the rail, waited behind the leaders along the inside on the second turn, angled out once in the stretch, moved out further with a furlong to go and closed well to be up in time. CHEF ERIC within striking distance three wide, moved in a bit before a half, was pocketed around the second turn, came out a bit for the drive, rallied, led late, missed. TONE IT DOWN forced the early pace four wide, gained a short lead on the second turn, took over with a furlong to go but was outfinished. GUARDED ENTRANCE behind the leaders four wide, challenged from that path on the second turn but tired in the drive. JIMANATOR outsprinted early five wide, moved to challenge in that path on the second turn but tired in the stretch. KING MESA vied for the lead while kept out in the three path and tired.
