Footnotes

TWIST OF SILVER settled in hand between horses, worked her way to the outside on the second turn, drew even five wide entering the stretch, kicked clear and maintained a diminishing advantage. STRONG WILLED LADY was reserved off of the inside, advanced between horses, came five wide into the stretch, angled out further to find clear sailing, finished well but was unable to bridge the gap. MAID OF HEAVEN settled saving ground, closed the gap through the second turn, shifted out and split horses entering the stretch, and finished willingly to earn the show. QUICK PRAISE was allowed to settle, tucked in to save ground, angled out leaving the second turn and was making up ground through the lane. PUDDY TAP settled off of the inside, advanced between horses, steadied from tight quarters near the seven-sixteenths pole, altered course to the outside on the second turn, moved up to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. RUN A RISK pulled to contention between horses, steadied inside the seven-sixteenths pole, recovered quickly, was within

reach to the final furlong and faltered. BREAKING PROMISES was forwardly placed along the inside to the stretch and retreated. SISTERHOOD stalked the pace in hand, moved up four wide to make her bid but came up empty after six furlongs. ANNABEL LEE opened clear to set the pace, was headed leaving the second turn and gave way readily. DOS LUNAS was never a factor. JUNE CLEAVER chased three wide but stopped before going six furlongs.
