Footnotes

ADAM'S TIME, within striking distance off the inside, moved closer after a half, dropped back a bit on the second turn, was angled out in upper stretch and rallied willingly late to be up in time. SUDLEY SPRINGS, bumped at the start, raced closest to the pace, challenged approaching the stretch, took over with a furlong to go but was outfinished. SOCLASSIE, forwardly placed, made a four wide move on the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. BOBECHE, outrun early, made a mild gain in the three path on the second turn but lacked the needed closing bid. CHARMING PRINCESS, unhurried early while saving ground, moved between rivals with three furlongs to go but had little left late. BURMESE RUBY, bumped at the start, set the pace off the inside, held well to midstretch and tired. TRICKLE DOWN, bumped at the start, raced close up along the inside but was through after five furlongs.
