Footnotes

CHARMU went up at once to force the pace while working his way inward, took over in the upper stretch, edged clear and was kept to his task. DREAM RUN, well placed from the outset, stalked the leaders four wide and couldn't threaten CHARMU in the drive as second best. ST. SALT drifted out at the start placing DIME in tight quarters, raced within striking distance while between rivals into the stretch, and lacked a closing response. SET OVER SET, also well placed between rivals into the stretch, came up empty. MISTER PENNY gained a slight edge inside early, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. TRION GEORGIA, outsprinted early, reached contention six wide concluding the turn but flattened out when straightened for the drive. SECRET ROMEO, outrun until the stretch, couldn't menace while improving position. DIAMOND T was six wide much of the way and outrun. DIME, sluggish to start and squeezed back, was outrun. MY GOLDEN SON saved ground and tired. TRAVEL CITY was finished early.
