GOLDEN MISSILE was hustled along after the start to vie for the lead outside CAT THIEF during the run to the first turn, gained command and cleared that rival entering the backstretch, raced four or wide and controlled the pace while racing within himself, edged in a bit on the second turn, repulsed an earnest challenge from CAT THIEF and CHESTER HOUSE nearing the final quarter, was tapped twice with the whip turned down about the eighth pole, once again approaching the final sixteenth and finished under mild hand encouragement. ECTON PARK, within striking distance and saving ground from the outset, was asked for a bit of run approaching the end of the backstretch, moved menacingly inside the winner approaching the stretch, fell back slightly when straightened for the drive, then, when soundly shake up with the whip lefthanded, proved clearly best of the others. CAT THIEF contested the pace inside the winner in the early stages, fell back of GOLDEN MISSILE and moved outside him on the backstretch, made a bold run four or five wide approaching the stretch to gain almost even terms but weakened when straightened for the drive. CHESTER HOUSE, unhurried into the backstretch and four wide much of the way, made a serious run leaving the three-eighths pole outside the winner but flattened out when straightened for the drive. ALY'S ALLEY tired on the second turn after stalking the early pace. K ONE KING, a bit sluggish at the start, was never a factor.
