Footnotes

CAROLINE'S GOLD, away in good order, settled near the inside, raced three wide, worked her way out eight wide when straightened for the drive and was hard ridden to prevail. NAUGHTY IS went up early to force the pace between foes under light rating, reached the front between calls in the upper stretch, was headed from the inside at the eighth pole by OVEROCKS, regained the edge briefly but couldn't contain CAROLINE'S GOLD in the late going. AUNTIE SOPH bobbed at the start, raced five wide on the backstretch, moved menacingly six or seven wide into the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. OVEROCKS, well placed inside from early on, made a bold run to reach the front at the eighth pole but failed to continue. SEEINSBELIEVEN gained the lead early, angled near the inside, made the pace to the stretch and faltered. SLEW PEG, outrun early and four or five wide, circled foes ten wide into the lane but failed to fire. ANGEL OF LOVE forced the pace early, raced forwardly to the stretch while four or five wide and flattened out. MOUNTAIN MAMBO gained a striking position early while racing in behind horses three or four wide, raced prominently for six furlongs and tired.
