Footnotes

CALLINGAHARDTEN outrun early, was in tight midway through the second turn when rallying along the inside, angled out in midstretch for a clear path and closed well to be clear. CODOY bumped with MIDDIE several times early, raced within striking distance three wide, moved up in that path late on the second turn, bumped repeatedly with OCEAN SEVEN (IRE) when that one came out with the winner then finished willingly for the place. AUSTONS SURE CURE prompted the pace three wide, dropped back a bit before a half, came again to challenge on the second turn and held on gamely. SETON HALL set the pace along the inside, responded willingly in the stretch and held on gamely. OCEAN SEVEN (IRE) reserved inside, steadied behind the leader with three furlongs to go, angled out for the drive, bumped with CODOY repeatedly in midstretch then weakened. MAX THE KNIFE unhurried early, was no threat. COUNT ON GOLD behind the leaders for six furlongs, gave way. MIDDIE bumped early, pressed the pace off the inside, stopped suddenly with three furlongs to go and was outdistanced.
