DYNA D., unhurried early, advanced four wide into the second turn, caught the leaders with a furlong to go and edged off late. COME ON BERTIE, forwardly placed while three wide, challenged on the second turn and held on gamely in the drive. STOP THE VICE alternated for the lead off the inside and also held on well in the drive. MINNIE HA HA set or forced the pace while saving ground and held on gamely in the stretch. WHERE'S MS. FENG, within striking distance off the inside, was angled out in upper stretch challenged with a furlong to go but tired late. WILE, outrun early in the three path, was angled out in upper stretch and closed well late. PLAY NOT, within striking distance off the inside, lacked a late bid. DYNA FORE ME, outrun early, was no threat. WHISPER AND RUN, forwardly placed inside, faded in the stretch. FESTINA steadied late on the first turn when in tight inside, could not menace. NORTHERN SIMBASH was outrun. WORRY'NSUSIE pressed the early pace four wide, and stopped in the final half.
