Footnotes

STORMY SOCIETY gained a slim lead inside early while dueling with OCTOBER OPTIMIST, shook off that one and opened a clear advantage, made the balance of the pace and lasted while drifting out repeatedly in the stretch under left-handed urging. STILL AS SWEET (IRE), never far back, raced in behind the leaders, angled four wide for the drive, came wider when the winner drifted and finished well. INIS moved inside on the backstretch, angled five wide into the lane, moved back inside in the final furlong when the winner drifted out and was closing well. SILVER TIE LADY, unhurried early, moved seven or eight wide into the stretch but lacked a late response. STARRY MARK drifted out at the start, was checked and angled inside, swung out six wide into the stretch but failed to rally. OCTOBER OPTIMIST moved up early to press the winner four wide, raced forwardly to the stretch and tired. TECHNO VISION wasn't a factor. FRILLS AND THRILLS stalked the pace four or five wide until nearing the stretch, weakened, then wasn't abused in the drive. EMILY'S MARK tired on the far turn while between foes four or five wide.
