Footnotes

JUSTAKISS leaned in at the start bumping TOP MAMBO, moved to the fore, raced two or three wide, was clear most of the way, then was kept to her task in the drive. PLATINEE, well placed inside early, eased out four wide on the far turn, loomed prominently outside the winner and was second best. RED QUEEN stalked the pace five wide into the stretch and lacked a closing account. RESOLUTION, four or five wide while outrun for six furlongs, angled wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. ABOLINNA, well placed three or four wide into the stretch, came up empty. CALL ME EPPI, within striking distance four wide into the final furlong, failed to fire. SEATTLE DANCING, outrun for six furlongs, came out eight wide for the drive and lacked a serious late account. BABY NEEDS SHOES failed to rally in an even effort. INFUSED came out bumping INFUSED at the start, was outrun inside, was steadied at the quarter-mile ground and never menaced after angling out. MISS HELEN WHEELS pressed the pace to the stretch and tired. TOP MAMBO, bumped from both sides at the start, tired on the far turn. DON'TCUSSTHEFIDDLE raced within striking distance near the inside for six furlongs and tired.
