The host association's added monies to be divided 62% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Closed Saturday, June 4, 2005 with 22 nominations.

Footnotes

DON'T GET MAD settled in hand four wide, commenced a sweeping rally approaching the final quarter, came out seven wide, took over, drew clear and was under urging to widen a bit at the end. UNBRIDLED ENERGY leaned in at the start bumping CRIMSON STAG, was never far back, raced four wide, moved out seven or eight wide for the stretch run and was second best. REAL DANDY, five wide into the backstretch, edged in soon after going a half, eased out and split horses three or four wide in the upper stretch and bested the others. FIRST WORD, within easy striking distance and four or five wide, moved to the challenge approaching the stretch, put his head in front briefly between calls a quarter-mile out, then weakened when straightened for the drive. BUCHAREST, inside early, eased out four wide on the backstretch to chase front-running CRIMSON STAG, inched to challenge on the far turn, put a head in front briefly just prior to going six furlongs, then weakened soon after. CRIMSON STAG, bumped at the start by UNBRIDLED ENERGY when that one leaned in, sprinted clear soon after, raced two or three wide, began to shorten stride leaving the backstretch and gave way readily upon going six furlongs.
