MUSIC CITY duelled for the lead along the inside, shook off BARGE late and gamely edged clear. BARGE duelled for the lead two wide, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the place. FREE BRAVE was allowed to settle, angled in and got through entering the stretch, finished well and was making up ground, following the race FREE BRAVE was unsaddled on the backstretch and vanned off. AWAKINO CAT chased the pace three deep, drifted out further entering the stretch and flattened out. CASSOULET settled saving ground, drifted out a bit entering the stretch and went evenly through the drive. HOLD THE SALT was allowed to settle, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. TURFISTE settled in hand within contention, but faltered between horses and faded. HAIL TO SHILOH was outrun.
