Weights to be announced Saturday, June 11. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 4, 2011 with 21 nominations.

POOL PLAY was unhurried into stride, settled near the tail of the field, commenced his rally with three furlongs to run, circled nine wide into the stretch, kept on gamely and was up in the final strides. MISSION IMPAZIBLE stalked the pace four wide, drew even nearing the three furlong marker, fought on gamely through a prolonged drive but was denied in the last jump. APART tracked the pace three wide, loomed a danger leaving the second turn, was bottled up between rivals through the drive but kept on well in a good effort. DUKE OF MISCHIEF settled in hand early, made a long drive circling five wide, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, but failed to sustain the drive. GIANT OAK was unhurried into stride, circled seven wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. FLAT OUT settled saving ground, got through to make his bid but failed to sustain the drive. CROWN OF THORNS settled off of the pace toward the inside under a hard hold, shifted out between horses on the backstretch, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. WORLDLY was forwardly placed along the inside for six furlongs and retreated. EQUESTRIO tucked in early to save ground, swung to the outside on the

second turn but failed to improve position. EL CABALLO was hustled along five wide to the second turn and dropped out. REGAL RANSOM set the pressured pace three wide, but came up empty between horses entering the stretch and stopped.
