Footnotes

MANDY JUD contested the pace inside early, dueled with that one into the stretch, edged clear and was kept to her task. OCTOBER OPTIMIST bobbed at the start and was bumped by ILLUSORY, went up to battle for the lead outside of MANDY JUD, raced close up into the lane and couldn't match strides late as second best. FLY FREE JANE was moved out five or six wide nearing the end of the backstretch, continued in that manner while making a run into the stretch and could gain only slightly in the drive. ILLUSORY ducked in at the start bumping OCTOBER OPTIMIST, tracked the pace five wide, loomed a solid threat entering the stretch but flattened out. CIMPLY SAVIO, within striking distance while five or six wide throughout, failed to rally. LITTLE IRISH GIRL raced five or six wide much of the way and tired. TENDER TOUCH, briefly in front after the start, raced forwardly for a half and faded near the inside.
