BLUE RIGHT BY bobbled a bit at the start, recovered quickly, pressed the pace off the inside and drew clear under steady urging. SATURDAY DANCE within striking distance, commenced his rally four wide on the turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. THANKS TO RON forwardly placed from the start, raced in the three path on the turn and lacked the needed closing bid. PRIME CUT broke in the air, was outrun early, moved out four wide midway through the turn and made a good late gain. GREAT BAM vied for the lead along the inside and tired late. CONSISTENTLYAFLEET reserved in the three path, could not menace. CLASSIC FRED was no threat while off the inside. BIG MACK DADDY drifted in after breaking slowly and was outrun. STORMY THE CAT close up while near the rail, stopped.
