ULTIMATE TRUTH pressed the pace four wide, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and edged off late. SHE CAN FLY within striking distance off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive and lodged a mild late bid for the place. RANAWAY YANKEE prompted the pace three wide and held on gamely. FRENCH SUNRISE within striking distance five wide, lacked a rally. LEARN THE LINGO maintained a slim lead off the inside for a half and tired. POSITIVELY PAIGE close up along the inside, tired. ALEX'S ALI outrun for a half, was no factor. SHEE'S SWIFT close up in the three path, faded. FIRST PRIZE was no factor while off the inside. BELL'S BELLES was outrun. CARIBBEAN CASTAWAY failed to menace.
