BRICKYARD HELEN rushed to the lead along the inside, edged clear entering the stretch and was fully extended to just last. TAPITFORPAR settled in hand, shifted out four wide to make her bid, finished well and was gaining with every stride. JANOU was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, moved out four wide and was just up to earn the show. PASSION TAMER hopped at the start, was allowed to settle, circled six wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. COWGIRL KNOCKOUT vied for the lead four wide to the stretch and faded. GO LYDIA GO was allowed to settled, came three wide but lacked the needed response when asked. LOKOMAMMA broke slowly and was never a factor. NEWPORT LULU pressed the pace between horses for a half and stopped.
