PLUTONIUM angled out when close up, moved up three wide on the second turn to challenge, drew clear into the stretch and stayed clear while kept to the task. ADULARE reserved off the inside, angled out for the drive but lodged only a mild bid for the place. SPORTY outrun for a half, made a run four wide on the second turn and closed well on the outside. JOES BLAZING AARON set the pace near the inside, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. MOONPORT outrun early, moved up in the three path on the second turn and made a good late gain. MEDAL ROUND was no threat. FORMAGGIO stumbled at the start and was outrun. PARTY HARD within striking distance, saved ground on the second turn and faded. PATHOKI pressed the pace off the inside and gave way.
